



RED BULL ROOKIE OF THE YEAR AWARD 2023

- The Red Bull Rookie of the Year award will solely be based on FMB sanctioned events in 2023.
- The Red Bull Rookie of the Year title will be awarded to the #1 ranked Male & #1 ranked Female Rookie Athlete based on the year end 2023 Red Bull Rookie Rankings.
- The Red Bull Rookie Rankings are comprised of an athletes' total score from their best three results from Gold, Silver and/or Bronze events in 2023. Further criteria are explained in the Rules & Regulations.

Contest Timeline

- Rookie Rankings: January 1, 2023 November 20, 2023
- ROTY Award Recipient Notified: The week following the last FMB sanctioned Gold, Silver or Bronze event of the 2023 season. **currently set to be November 20, 2023**

Award / Prizing

Red Bull Male Rookie of the Year Award 2023

Award Recipient will receive:

- Wildcard entry to the first Crankworx Slopestyle event in 2024 with flights and accommodation included

 - EUR 500,- spending money
- 2024 FMB World Tour License

Red Bull Female Rookie of the Year Award 2023

Award Recipient will receive:

- Up to 2,500 € provided as travel support to a FMB sanctioned women's event in 2024
- o Red Bull Rookie of the Year Trophy
- EUR 500,- spending money
- o 2024 FMB World Tour License

Eligibility

- Athlete must have a current FMB World Tour Men's License, FMB World Tour Women's License or a FMB Free Amateur Men's License
- Athlete must not yet have competed at a Diamond event in any previous year. 2023 must be the athlete's first year competing at a Diamond event to be eligible
- Athlete must be between the ages of 16 25 years old (as of December 31, 2023) to be eligible for participation
- Athlete cannot be a previous Red Bull Rookie of the Year award recipient.
- In order to qualify and register as Participant without parental consent, you must be at least 18 years old at the time of entry. If you are under the age of majority in your country of residence at the time of entry, you confirm that you have obtained the consent of your parent/legal guardian to your participation and to all applicable terms and conditions. On request, you are obliged to provide evidence proving that you are above the age of majority in your country of residence or your parent(s) and/or legal guardian has given consent as described above in written form.
- The FMBA will evaluate the criteria annually to ensure it is in line with the progression of the sport.

Rookie Rankings – Rules and Regulations

Athletes need to meet the outlined eligibility criteria for participation and adhere to the Rules and Regulations.

- Rookie Rankings will comprise of the total score from an athletes' best three results from Gold, Silver and/or Bronze events in 2023.
- An athlete must compete in <u>at least one</u> Gold, Silver and/or Bronze event in 2023 to be ranked on the Rookie Ranking.
- An athlete can compete in as many Gold, Silver and/or Bronze events in 2023, but only their best three results will be totaled and appear on the Rookie Rankings.
- Prize package for the Red Bull Female Rookie of the Year Award, is contingent on Silver Slopestyle taking place in 2024. If it is not held, another comparable event will be offered or a travel budget will be provided.

Tie Break Rules

In the event of a tie for total points at the end of the FMB 2023 season, the outlined rules below will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- 1. The most first place finishes at the highest event level, or if still tied, the most second place finishes, or if still tied, the most third place finishes (all within the 2023 season). If still tied ...
- 2. The highest result at the highest level of an event where both competitors competed (ex: both competed at a Silver level event and that was the highest level of an event each competitor competed at in 2023, whoever placed higher and got the better result, will be ranked higher). If still tied ...
- a. If both competitors have not competed at the same event, then proceed to the 3rd Tie Break Rule
- 3. In the event the tie cannot be broken using the above rules, the title and prize money will be divided equally.
